 - We didn't win any of the membership trophies because our renewals trickled to nothing in Feb.

 - Member Van Delist held Boys State planning meetings over the 2 days to get materials ready for 2020 Boys State.
 - Harris planned and orchestrated the 2020 Oratorical competition. He made a couple of faux pas during announcements, but as yet has not been fired.
 Fuller filled in as chaplain during the event.

- Post 22 bid on the 2024 Summer convention but was beat out by Post 8 from Pierre. The DEC asked that those who weren't selected consider bidding on the 2025 Convention.
- Membership (Harris): Currently at 88% of goal (559 pd/goal of 638).

- Americanism (D. Fuller)
 - Boys State and Youth Trooper Academy Recruiting school visits
 - Visits to STM (2), RC Christian (1), and Central HS (2) where we addressed a class of JROTC Junior Boys. One visit to Stevens where we were only allowed to sit in the cafeteria.
 - Van Delist talked about Boys State. What it is and how it works. Why
 everyone should be helping us recruit boys.
 - Currently have one application from a Stevens HS boy.
- Athletic Officer (Tolsma stood in): Talked about the fact that so far 70 players have signed up. Also, we have bid on the 2021 and 22 National Regional tournament and they are coming here to do a site visit on 23-24 March 2020. Asked for information on when we started our team – possibly in 1926.
- **Sick call, relief and employment** (Fuller): Our member Cynthia Douglas announced that she has Lymphoma and is currently receiving treatment. Melvin Lehman, James Trenary, Delmar Sorenson, Norbert Johnson have died during the month of Feb. Post Everlasting coming up...asked for volunteers for Riflemen and Brazier carrier. Last Man Standing is going well...lots of new bottles.
- Post Service Officer report (Van Delist)
 - o In the last month we provided money to the Dept...see amounts shown above.
 - o Provided a run down on what we have done over the last year.

Unfinished Business

- Status of Gun Raffle (Tolsma): First round was completed on Friday the 21st of Feb.
 One of our members, Gary Stanley won the machine gun. Harris reminded everyone that the reason for this raffle is to raise money to repair our VERY leaky roof(s).
 - We have now started selling \$10 tickets for the remaining guns (8).
- Facility upgrades/expenses (Tolsma/Harris)
 - Electrical upgrades: New LED lighting installed This is an upgrade in both ascetics and energy savings.
 - In Bar (Multi color rope lights Harris/Tolsma/Van Delist)
 - Can lights above bar (Tom Smith)
 - **Dart room** Troffer Lights (Harris/Tom Smith).
 - WHY? The new LED lights in all areas use less than 20% of what the old T-12 florescent bulbs used in the same space.
 - THE GOAL: replace all T-12 and T-8 lights in the meeting rooms with LED lights (with the ability to dim) by this summer...significant savings on power and may earn us a rebate from BHE.
 - Motion sensors installed in bathrooms to control lighting (Tom Smith). This
 will further limit energy use, as the lights will go out after 15 minutes if no
 one is in the room, as well as turning them off at night.

- Ceiling tiles replaced in down ramp area leading to kitchen (Harris and Smith). Freshens up that area.
- Old unused furnace removed from the utility/storage area near kitchen (Van Delist). Allows more room to store cleaning equipment.

- Membership (Harris): Current Goal Status.
 - Approximately 91% of goal
 - Renewals have slowed to less than a trickle.
- Americanism (D. Fuller Post/D. Harris Dept Americanism Officer/C. Van Delist Director of SD Boys State)
 - Fuller: Boys State and Youth Trooper canceled. School medals being delivered to schools for distribution to students. 14 so far for junior and senior high.
 - Harris: National Ruling on who can attend Boys State Basically determined it was up to individual states – Harris will be pushing to include both Juniors and Seniors for 2021.
 - Van Delist: Boys State was supposed to start on the 1st of June. Canceled. The Boys State Board will meet in August or early September. Currently leaning toward including both Juniors and Seniors next year. We are looking at moving the program back to 6 days vice 5 to allow more time for the boys to move through the program. The monies that were paid for the 2020 boys was sent back to the Posts with an encouragement to save it for next year.
- Athletic Officer (Beau Garcia via Zoom)
 - Baseball is back! Post 22 will start playing in early June. Hardhats have 12 playing dates and 3 tournaments scheduled. Firecracker and Black Hills Veterans tournaments are a go. Once that happens, they will be taking applications. The funds must be distributed before December 31st, 2020.
 - Assuming we receive a grant, the plan is to use it toward covering business losses during that period and to partially repair our roof.
