- o Finance (Harris): All as of 01/27/2021
  - Business: \$
  - Membership: \$ (Transferred \$2,000 to the Americanism Fund on 1/11/21 to cover our commitment to Post 22 Baseball)
  - Benevolence: \$ (received \$500 from business to this account v. \$300)
    - Funds donated since last meeting: 1) Club For Boys \$100; 2) Scouts of America Black Hills Area Council - \$100; 3) Meals on Wheels Western SD - \$100.
  - Americanism: \$ (-\$2,500 check written to Post 22 Baseball for 2021 sponsorship)

  - Installed new toilet in the Men's restroom (\$500).
  - Plan to replace regular lighting in Sm. Mtg. room with LED lights in the near future (Smith and Harris).

#### New Business

- Midwinter Conference was canceled due to ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
  - The Department Oratorical Contest will still be held "in-person" on 21 February at 1030 in Oacoma. All participants/guests/audience members will be required to wear masks and observe social distancing.
- Queen of Hearts raffle (\$3,111) was won by Brenda Hveem on 17<sup>th</sup> of January. 50% of the pot goes to the winner amount of \$1,555.50. Another \$777 went into the Capital Improvement Savings account to help pay for roof repairs. \$777 went back into the raffle.
- Gun Raffle has changed slightly. The weapons offered are slightly different than the original selection. The weapons now shown on the board have already been

- purchased so that whoever wins the raffle is able to receive the weapon quickly. The pandemic caused a shortage/slowdown of available guns.
- Establishment of Scholarships. Executive Committee approved and established scholarships for Oratorical/Boys State/Veteran Student. A separate bank account will be created to save the awarded monies until the winning students begin secondary schools.
  - \$1,000 for Oratorical (\$250 post/\$250 District/\$500 state for total of \$1,000)
    - Our current participant has already earned \$500 of this money and will earn the remaining \$500 if she wins at the State competition – good luck Emma!
  - \$1,000 for Boys State (Will be awarded to Boy with most successful record at Boys State – still working out the details).
  - \$1,000 from the benevolence fund for a Veteran currently attending a postsecondary institution.

  - Smith and Harris recently completed lighting upgrade in Large and small meeting rooms. All LED lighting now. Cost for parts: \$614. Labor savings of at least \$500
    - Will be adding two more 2X4 LED light fixtures in the large meeting room to eliminate the poorly lit area. It will look like the sun is coming up back there, but we intend to install wiring to allow for dimming the lights as needed.
    - Ordering more lights for bathrooms (6) and spares: est. cost = \$270
  - Scheduling 5-year fire sprinkler inspection/nozzle (etc.) replacement project in near future = \$1,580 cost.
