• Post Service Officer (H. Rossander)

All veterans exposed to toxins and other hazards during military service, whether at home or abroad, are now eligible for VA healthcare. VA is expanding health care eligibility to millions of veterans including all who served in the Vietnam war, Gulf war, Iraq or Afghanistan or any other combat zone after 9/11, which is years earlier than what's called for by the PACT act. These veterans will be eligible to directly enroll in VA health care without applying first for VA benefits. Also, veterans who never deployed but were exposed to toxins or hazards while training or on active duty in the U.S. will also be eligible for enrollment.
